About the GNRC Sixth Forum

Arigatou International will convene the GNRC Sixth Forum from 19 to 21 November 2024 in Abu Dhabi, United Arab Emirates. As the GNRC approaches a quarter-century of interfaith collaboration, action, and dialogue in the service of children around the world, the Sixth Forum is a pivotal moment for members to reflect on and celebrate the successes and positive transformations achieved since the Network was inaugurated in 2000 at its first Forum.

Hosted by the **Interfaith Alliance for Safer Communities** (IAFSC), the upcoming Forum will bring together leaders of diverse faith and spiritual traditions, representatives from various governmental, intergovernmental, and non-governmental organizations, and children (who will have met in advance for a three-day forum to prepare for their participation at the main Forum). The Sixth Forum will be a hybrid event. In addition to the 400-600 in-person attendees, another 600 participants are expected to attend virtually. The participants will share ideas and formulate concrete strategies and plans for a hopeful world for, and with, children.

OBJECTIVES

The primary objective of the Forum is to bring together GNRC members, diverse religious leaders, children, youth, policymakers, academics, representatives from child-focused NGOs, and members of faith communities to deliberate, collaborate, exchange best practices, and forge new action commitments to address global issues concerning children.

Specifically, the Forum aims to:

Provide Space for Collaboration

Provide a space for authentic and effective collaboration between and among children and adults from diverse regions and religions.

Spotlight the Critical Situation of the World's Children

Put a spotlight on the critical situation of the world's children and reaffirm our commitment to addressing these present-day realities in the spirit of the GNRC.

Demonstrate Contributions by Religious Communities

Demonstrate the unique contributions, as well as clear and tangible actions, that religious communities and their ethical values can make to address the challenges children face.

Formulate New Action Plans

Build upon the transformative agenda, initiatives, actions, and expertise of Forum participants to shape new collaborative action for, and with, children.

Strengthen and Celebrate the GNRC

Strengthen the GNRC and celebrate nearly 25 years of interfaith cooperation.

Build New Synergies and Partnerships

Formulate and commit to concrete strategies and actions, build synergies, and develop new strategic partnerships that will support the scaling up of key programs for children.

Launch the Strategic Plan

Launch the GNRC Strategic Plan for 2025 – 2030.
